## Financial Report through June 2021

Through our first six months of 2021 our income exceeded our expenses versus our projected budget by \$15,599. This is due to our miscellaneous income being \$14,397 greater than anticipated. Our miscellaneous income includes \$33,675 which is the full amount of the 2<sup>nd</sup> PPP Loan we received.

Our expenses were \$2,326 less than expected. Savings from our personnel expenses and our ministries were the primary areas that resulted the expense savings.

On the income side our overall giving was \$660 less than our goal to date. Our Faithful Givers were \$636 greater than expected and our Pledgers were \$1,296 less than anticipated

We will continue to provide updates regarding our financial health throughout 2021.
