#### Dear Friends,

Forty one years ago this March 24th, Archbishop Oscar Romero, San Salvador, was assassinated as he stepped to the altar of a small chapel at a Sunday evening service. He had been active in speaking out against poverty, social injustice and torture and was on the record as lifting up the struggle of his people for basic human rights.

In his writings he reminds Christians to "step back" and view things from God's perspective. "The Kingdom is not only beyond our efforts; it is beyond our vision. We accomplish in our lifetime only a tiny fraction of the magnificent enterprise that is the Lord's work."

All around us are avenues of injustice that have so cruelly targeted various groups of people. Sometimes it seems as if the racism and sexism and ageism, etc. will never end. And it is very discouraging. The recent trial of police officer Derrick Chauvin in the George Floyd case is an example of accountability for one egregious act toward a fellow human being. It is but a small step in the direction of kingdom life and it doesn't seem to make much of a dent in all the wrongs and injustices experienced by the folks around us.

Romero reminds us don't be discouraged. God sees the vision and the future. The "magnificent enterprise" is just around the bend! Keep the faith; be hopeful; plant the seeds of God's Spirit wherever you find yourself. God will do the rest.

#### **Financial Report through March 2021**

Through our first three months of 2021 our expenses exceeded our income versus our projected budget by \$9,263.

Our expenses were \$1,484 greater than expected. This is due to having three payroll cycles in March. Our ministries continue to do a good job managing their expenses.

On the income side our overall giving was \$1,488 greater than our goal to date. Our Faithful Givers were \$174 greater than expected and our Pledgers were \$1,315 greater than anticipated. Our miscellaneous income was less than expected.

We received a 2<sup>nd</sup> PPP Loan for \$33,675 which was funded on February 12<sup>th</sup>. Our first PPP Loan of \$33,675 was completely forgiven and has been paid off as of March 23<sup>rd</sup>.

We have received 78% of the pledge cards for 2021 as compared to 2020. It's not too late to submit your pledge. This will help us determine what our expected pledge amount would be for 2021.

Ken Ingra will be stepping down as treasurer of the Finance Committee and Trustees as of 12/31/2021. He will provide the year end Treasurer reports at the January 2022 meeting. If the Finance Chair position has not been filled, Ken will fill that role.

We will continue to provide updates regarding our financial health throughout 2021.

Thank you for your continued support of our ministries through your pledges and faithful giving.







