Financial Report through March 2022

Through our first three months of 2022 our expenses exceeded our income versus our projected budget by \$11,811. This is due to our miscellaneous income and overall giving being less than anticipated.

Our expenses were \$1,130 greater than expected which is within 1% of our budget.

On the income side our overall giving was \$1,876 less than our goal to date. This is \$2,739 better than our last reported amount. Our Faithful Givers were \$389 less than anticipated and our Pledgers were \$1,487 less than our goal. Our miscellaneous income was \$8,816 less than our budget which is not unusual at this time of year.

We will provide a status of the Stewardship Program in our next report. We will continue to provide updates regarding our financial health throughout 2022.
